Precis of Documents

N^o. 1. Foundation Deed. Dated. 1. July. 1755.

This indenture made the 1st. Day of July in the 29th year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord, George the Second, (by the grace of God of great Britain, France, & Ireland, King, Defender of the faith) and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty-five;

Between the Rev. George Holme, Clerk, D.D., Rector of Headley, of the one part

and of the Rev. Joseph Browne, D.D. Rector of Bramshott.

of the other part. Witnesseth that Whereas
the said Rev. Holme for the common good of the said Parish of Headley
& for furthering & promoting the useful education of young persons
of both sexes of the said Parish of Headley, more particularly of such
children as are or shall be born of poor & indigent parents has for
some time past instituted & set up a charity school in the said
Parish for teaching & instructing 12 poor children of either sex
of the said Parish (or in case of a deficiency of such children
therein, of poor children of the Parishes of Bramshott & Kipsey
in the said County) in such principles of learning & knowledge as
are most proper for such young persons, that is to say, the boys
in Reading, Writing, & common Arith: And the girls in Reading
& Writing, & Arith: & in Sewing, & Knitting: — (and has appointed
Nathaniel Bayley to be the present Schoolmaster to teach the
said boys who is also to provide a proper person to instruct the
said girls in Sewing & Knitting;) — & the said George Holme
has hitherto made a proper provision for the maintenance of
the said Schoolmaster, & is desirous to leave the said school and a

competent allowance to the master thereof for the time being continued & kept up for ever for the purpose aforesaid & to settle & assure a sufficient & perpetual fund for that purpose under such direction & in such manner as is hereafter mentioned.

Now therefore it is hereby declared to be the true intent & meaning of the said Gov: Holme & of all the other parties to these presents that the said Char: School may & shall have a perpetual continuance from henceforth for ever for the good purpose aforesaid, & that the said school shall consist of one master & any number of children of either sex of whom only twelve that are or shall be poor & indigent parents shall be taught upon the charity now intended to be established, the said master & children to be respectively named & appointed in manner herein after directed & that the said school shall be called Headley Charity School.

And for providing

a constant succession of masters of the said school it is hereby further declared

that the said Nathaniel Bayley shall be & he is hereby appointed first & present master of the said school, and that all & all succeeding masters shall continue respectively in the office of master until his (& their respective) deaths or until he (& they respectively) shall voluntarily resign, or be removed from the said office of master (which shall first happen) & for certaining what shall be a voluntary resignation of the said office, it is hereby declared that such resignation (may &) shall be made by any note in writing under the hand of the master for the time being, (signifying & importing such resignation) to be delivered to the Rector of Branshott & Greatham & Vicar of Selborne (aforesaid for the time being) or left at their

notice in writing of such appeal under his hand to said Rector of Bram: & Great: & Vicar of Selb: & also to the said Rector of Headley, or by leaving such notice at their respective Parsonage or Vicarage houses in the presence of one credible witness within one calendar month after such note or act of removal shall be delivered or left as aforesaid which Rectors of Bramshott & Great: & Vic: of Selb: for time being or any two of them may & are hereby empowered therupon to meet in the Schoolroom belonging to the Said school or at some other convenient place in the Parish of Headley at a day & hour to be appointed by them & intimated as well to the said Rector of Headley as to the said Master; & there & there to examine whether there be sufficient cause for removing the said Master or no and as their discretion by writing under their hands to confirm & establish or to reverse & annul the note (or act) of removal of the Rector of Headley Provided

that if such note or act of removal shall not in this manner be actually reversed within the space of two calendar months after the same shall be delivered or left as aforesaid, it shall therefore stand in full force and be absolutely irreverible

And Further

for defining & ascertaining in what manner a new Master of the said school shall be appointed on every Vacancy either by the death of the Master of the time being or by his resignation or removal in manner before specified it is hereby declared

that such new Master (may &) shall be appointed {by the Rectors of B. & g. & the Vic: of S. (for time being) or any two of them, during the life of the said gen: Holme or by the Rector of Headley (only) from his decease & for ever after} by writing under their respective

their respective parsonage or vicarage houses, in the presence
of one credible witness, during the life of the said Geo: Holme
& to be delivered to the Rector of Headley for the time being (only)
or left at his Parsonage house in the presence of such witness
(from the death of the said Geo: Holme & forever afterward);
And for ascertaining in what manner (the said Nathaniel Bayley
& all succeeding masters may be removed from the said office
of master. It is hereby provided

and declared that (the said Rector of Branshott & Greatton &
Vicar of Selborne for time being or any two of them during the
life of the said Geo: Holme & from his death & forever
afterwards) the Rector of Headley for the time being (only) (shall
& may at (their &) his discretion remove every such master
by a note in writing under (their &) his (respective) hand(s)
signifying & importing such removal & by delivering the
same to such master or leaving it at the school-room or
dwelling house of such master in sight of his school in the
presence of one credible witness

Provided that

(after the death of the said Geo: Holme) the Rector of Headley
for the time being shall in every such note (writing, or act)
of removal (to be signed by him) specify (& express) the reason of
such removal, & that such rector before he proceed to remove
shall admonish the said master twice before one credible
witness to correct his fault.

And Provided that

if the master receiving such note (or act) of removal from the
Rector of Headley shall think himself aggrieved thereby he may
appeal from the same to the Rector of Branshott & Greatton
and the Vicar of Selborne for the time being by delivering a
notice
