

Link Walk C – between Walks 4 and 5

Between Hambledon church and Oakhurst Cottage

Distance approximately ½ mile

From Hambledon church, take the Greensand Way south-west. This passes through a kissing-gate and across two fields before dropping to meet a road via a house drive. Turn left along the road, taking care round a blind bend where there is no footpath. Shortly, at a road junction, go slightly left down an accommodation road past terraced houses. Follow this – it becomes a narrow track, going downhill to meet another road. Cross the road and follow the marked right-of-way across the gravel in front of a house and past garages into the woods. Shortly, when it meets a more substantial track used by vehicles, turn right, then at a T-junction turn left down a narrow track leading to the National Trust property Oakhurst Cottage.

Circular Walk 5 continues from here from its Point 3. For Witley Station, turn right and follow it in the reverse direction for 1½ miles. For Chiddingfold and all points south, turn left and follow it in the direction described.



Oakhurst Cottage

Oakhurst Cottage is a small 16th Century timber-framed cottage containing furniture and artefacts reflecting several centuries of continued occupation. There is a delightful cottage garden.
