

Link Walk J – Havant to Portsmouth Harbour

***Visiting: Langstone, Hayling Billy coastal path, Hayling Island West Town,
Fort Cumberland, Eastney, Southsea***

Distance approximately 14 miles/22.5km

**The walk starts at Havant Station and ends at Portsmouth Harbour station;
refreshment at *The Ferry Boat Inn* and locations in Southsea and
Portsmouth**

Follow Circular Walk 14 from Havant station to point 3, then continue south along the Hayling Billy Coastal Path. When it terminates at the old station, carry straight on along Staunton Road and turn right at the end along Sea Front. This becomes Ferry Road and leads to the foot ferry which crosses to Portsea Island. *The Ferry Boat Inn* offers refreshment here.

From the ferry landing, take the road past Fort Cumberland to the start of the Esplanade which runs all the way along the coast to Southsea. Follow this, picking up the Millennium walkway (and Walk 15) after you pass Clarence Pier and its fun fair, arriving eventually at Portsmouth Harbour station.
